5th Grade Guided Reading Groups

I usually have about 5-6 groups of students, depending on class size. I meet with my below grade level reading groups four days a week. My on-grade level and above-grade level groups meet with me 2-3 days a week. When I meet with my guided reading groups, we read books, magazines, or passages depending on the strategy/skill we are focusing on.

Guided Reading | Weekly Plans

In third grade, you will likely not need to meet with all students in a guided reading group. My groups consist of students who are reading exactly at grade level or below. I do not place students who are reading above grade level in a guided reading group. I try to meet with them once every week or so to check in with their reading selections.
