This approach is evident in the organisation and titling of Hobsbawm's history of the world since 1789, which he divided into four volumes: Age of Revolution (1789-1848), Age of Capital (1848-1875), Age of Empire (1875-1914) and Age of Extremes (1914-1991). In Hobsbawm's view, the policies of the Cold War were driven by realpolitik rather than ideology. The Soviet Union was economically devastated by World War II, Hobsbawm argues, and had no capacity for expansion or war with the West.
