### Abstracts - The Writing Center

To write an abstract, start with a short paragraph that explains the purpose of your paper and what it's about. Then, write a paragraph explaining any arguments or claims you make in your paper. Follow that with a third paragraph that details the research methods you used and any evidence you found for your claims.

Informative Abstract The majority of abstracts are informative. While they still do not critique or evaluate a work, they do more than describe it. A good informative abstract acts as a surrogate for the work itself. That is, the researcher presents and explains all the main arguments and the important results and evidence in the paper.

Specifically, the requirements for the informative abstract are as follows: Summarize the key facts, conclusions, and other important information in the body of the report. Equals about 10 percent of the length of a 10-page report: for example, an informative abstract for a 10-page report would be 1 page.
