Mary & Joseph go to Bethlehem Lk. 2:1-5 Mary and Joseph travel to Bethlehem in Judaea , where Joseph's family live (see 1 on Map 4). The journey takes four or five days as Nazareth is 65 miles / 105 km north of Jerusalem , while Bethlehem is a hilltop town situated on a ridge near the edge of the Judeaan desert , 5 miles / 8km south of Jerusalem .

Luke records that Mary and Joseph travelled to Bethlehem because Joseph's family came from Bethlehem. It is likely, therefore, that Mary and Joseph went to stay with their relatives in Bethlehem. While Romans and other foreign travellers often stayed in roadside hostelries or 'inns' (see Luke 10:30-35), Jews never stayed in 'inns'.

For Mary and Joseph, their journey took them to Bethlehem and there are two roads they could have taken. The road on the eastern side of the Jordan River would have been the easiest road to take.
